

CUSTOMS

The following list is a guide that the American Women's Club customarily follows. These can be modified, as the Board and club decides, without a motion.

- Following the Annual General Meeting (AGM) election, notification of the new board should be forwarded to the following (not all inclusive); Alexander Library infolink, American Australian Association, American Chamber of Commerce, AW Clubs, AWC Website, Bank Account, FAWCO and The US Consulate in Perth.
- Following the AGM election if there are any new people in the positions of President, Secretary, or Treasurer, they need to change the signatories with the bank account, having a copy of the AGM minutes showing the newly elected board.
- General Meetings (GM) are held day or night, and north or south of the river. September is Founders' Day, held as a luncheon; December is generally held in the evening. (July 2011)
- Personal Direct Marketing at general meetings is frowned upon.
- Floral tributes are given at Memorial Services for Commemoration of the Battle for the Coral Sea and USA's Memorial Day.
- A hostess gift is given to the US Consul General if hosting the December GM at The Residence.
- A gift and flowers are presented to the outgoing President at the AGM.
- Women and men must wear a hat when presenting a wreath to be laid at any service. (June 2007)
- Women visiting The Parliament House or The Government House must wear a skirt. (June 2007)
- The AWC will be the chartering organization for the Boy Scouts of America in Perth (September 2008)
- The newsletter editor may be invited to attend Board Meetings, as a non-voting member, at the discretion of the presiding board. (July 2011)

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
